ABOUT THE EVENT

PAINT KERRVILLE is a non-juried membership paint out event presented by the Outdoor Painters Society and Kerr Arts and Cultural Center, Kerrville, Texas. Artists will compete for \$5,000+ in awards. Artists paint for 2 days and nights at selected locations within the city of Kerrville and the surrounding area. **This is an “open membership competition” that will be capped at 50 artists.** Competition artists will have the opportunity to interpret Kerrville and the surrounding Hill Country area as only a plein air painter can. The Exhibition will be in the Kerr Arts & Cultural Center. A percentage of sales from the exhibition will benefit KACC.

Important dates, deadlines and event schedule

- Registration is open to OPS members (Signature and Associate)
- Event is limited to the First 50 registrations with a Wait List.
- Orientation and Check-in – September 21, 2021
- Official Paint Out: September 22-23-24, 2021
- Turn In Deadline: 2:00 pm September 24, 2021
- Exhibition Preview VIP Reception 7:00 pm, September 24, 2024
- Exhibition open to public: September 25, 2021
- Quick Paint – 9 AM-Noon: September 25, 2021
- Exhibition ends – pick up unsold work: 8:00 pm, September 25, 2021
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ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ **Entrant must be at least 18 years of age and a member of Outdoor Painters Society.** Join or renew at www.outdoorpainterssociety.com.
- ✓ **To qualify, current Associate, Signature, and Master Signature members must renew on or before entry deadline: Midnight, June 30, 2021 MEMBERSHIP STATUS WILL BE VERIFIED**
- ✓ **There will be no refund of entry fee if disqualified for non-payment of dues by deadline. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

ENTRY FEE:

A Fee of \$65.00 is due upon registration. The fee is non-refundable! Check your calendar for any conflicts before registering.

CONFIRMATION OF ACCEPTANCE:

Artists will receive confirmation of registration by email. Participating artists will receive an additional e-mail with instructions, lodging suggestions, and other pertinent data. Registration and paid entry fee constitute agreement with all conditions set forth in this prospectus.

ABOUT KACC:

Kerr Arts and Cultural Center was founded in 1995 by a group of community artists with a mission of providing a show place for local artists and furthering the art and cultural education of the community. With a vision of being the arts and cultural anchor of a vibrant downtown area, the cultural hub of the Hill Country, and a nationally recognized arts destination, KACC continues to grow and expand its programs and services for local arts, artisans, and patrons of the arts.

PARTICIPATION RULES:

1. There will be no exceptions to deadlines, specifications or rules.
2. Participants must abide by rules of the event as outlined in prospectus
3. Participants must participate in event activities as listed in event itinerary (distributed at orientation)
4. Participants must attend orientation and welcome reception.
5. Artist will complete W-9 form & submit to KACC (form will be provided at check-in)
6. Artist may bring one (1) plein air painting from personal inventory for initial display in designated gallery space (Submit painting at Check-In.)
7. One (1) Quick Draw painting may be submitted. (Rules provided at Check-In)
8. Art work will hang "Salon Style".
9. Maximum of five (5) pieces, (including 1 from home) plus Quick Draw, for a total of 6 paintings.
10. Paintings must be created during the official painting period of September 22-24 to be eligible for awards (Painting from home is for sale but not eligible for awards).
11. **Paintings must be for sale with a \$350 minimum price.** No exceptions.
12. Sales split: 25% to KACC and 75% to the artist.
13. **Minimum size: no side smaller than 8" excluding frame.** No Exceptions
14. **Maximum size: No side may exceed 20 inches,** excluding frame. No exceptions.
15. All work must be in gallery quality frames "wired" (no saw-tooth hangers) and ready for hanging. No exceptions.
16. **No Gallery Wraps.**
17. Pick up of unsold work by the artist or artist's agent at close of exhibition, 8:00 pm, September 25.

RESPONSIBILITIES/LIABILITIES OF THE ARTIST

By entering the event, you agree that you have read and will abide by all rules outlined in this prospectus.
